

Kingdom of Christ Global Manifesto

The Holy Scriptures are the best source of knowledge. Having that knowledge comes with a responsibility and duty to share it. In recognition of the Evil that continues to sweep across this World unchecked and untamed, it has become absolutely necessary to make some firm declarations. We, the Kingdom of Christ, the Kingdom Communion, the Perfect Church, the Chief Apostle, and all such affiliates do hereby establish this manifesto.

Opposition to Democracy and Republicanism:

The words democracy and republicanism are defined as a government established by the people. Such a form of governance implies an evolution of self-rule. The Holy Scriptures according to **Proverbs 21:2** teach that – all men believe their ways are right, but God ponders the heart. We are further taught according to **Proverbs 16:2** – that the ways of man are clean in his own eyes, but the Lord weighs the spirits. Additionally, scripture warns us according to **Proverbs 16:25** – the ways of man seems right to him, but this results in death. Finally, according to **Luke 16:15** clause (c) – that which is highly esteemed by men is an abomination in the sight of God.

The point is that we are NOT equipped to govern ourselves without the direction of God. According to **Isaiah 55:8** – God’s thoughts are not our thoughts and HIS ways are not our ways. Further, in **Isaiah 55:9** – God’s thoughts are higher than our thoughts and HIS ways are higher than our ways. All of the above reveal that God’s thoughts and ways are far superior to any one man. We need God to think for us and to guide us. The Holy Scriptures commands us according to **Proverbs 3:5-6** to TRUST in the LORD in all thy heart, lean NOT to thy own understanding, and in all thy ways acknowledge HIM and HE shall direct your paths.

The aforementioned scriptures clearly show that we are incapable of self-governance. We don’t even have superior thought. We are commanded to submit to God in our thoughts and our ways. Democracy and Republicanism doesn’t afford us the opportunity to manifest and express these sentiments. Such form of governance completely disregard the rule of God and leaves those whom worship HIM with no option, but to voice full opposition to the same.

It is necessary to include in this statement that according to **Isaiah 33:22** – God is our Judge, our Lawgiver, our King, and our Savior. There is nothing that can compare to such authority, nor power. Democracy and Republicanism will always be contrary to scripture.

Opposition to Voting for Political Candidates:

The act of voting is about making a choice. According to the American Heritage Dictionary the formal definition of the word VOTE is – to declare or pronounce by general consent. Further, the word is informally defined as – to state as a preference or opinion. When VOTING comes to mind it often brings about other words of interest. Some of those words are – support, aid, assist, bless, encourage, protect, advocate, ally, disciple, endorse, follow, help, sponsor, subscribe, uphold, abet, advance, approve, establish, justify, promote, affirm, certify, favor, confirm, okay,

The Holy Scriptures teach according to **Ephesians 4:27** to – neither give place to the devil. The word place suggests opportunity, freedom, moment, and convenience. Further, we are taught according to **Romans 13:14** to – put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the lust of the flesh. This applies in every context be it personal, social, religious, political, and any other context. As the saints of GOD we have been instructed to be blameless. **Philippians 2:15**, teaches that– we be BLAMELESS and harmless the sons of GOD without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom we shine as lights in the world. Not only are the saints commanded to be blameless, but to teach them to be so, the Bishop is commanded to be blameless. Now, if this is what God expects from his Bishop (the Pastor), then he also expects that from other leaders as well.
